### Los pasos a seguir para acceder a Oxford Owl son los siguientes:

- A- Ingresar [www.oxfordowl.co.uk](http://www.oxfordowl.co.uk) o mediante Google buscar OXFORD OWL y hacer click en el primer link.
- B- Entrar al sitio y hacer click en la solapa "MY CLASS LOGIN" ubicada en la parte superior de la página.
- C- Ingresar el "CLASS NAME" (ingresar "losmolinos" y el grado y letra del grado de su hijo en 2020; ejemplo: losmolinos1c) y la "PASSWORD" (1234) y luego hacer click en "LOGIN"
- D- Al ingresar a la siguiente página, hacer click en "MY BOOKSHELF"
- E- Luego, en el buscador del sitio ("SEARCH") ingrese el título sugerido por el maestro.
- F- Hacer click sobre el libro para acceder al mismo.
- G- Para elegir otro título, siga los mismos pasos.
